Deputy High, Our School

## In Remembrance

In 1909 Deputy was a certified school with Anna Nay as the first graduate from this three year high school.

In 1912 Deputy, now a commissioned school, had five graduates: Merle Taff, Xie Hopkins, Ruth Gudgel, Clara Sutton, and Elizabeth Wallace.

Until 1954 all twelve grades were held in the seven room grade school building.

There was no gym so the boys practiced under the old elm tree. They played their games by flickering gas lights at the pavilion by the camp grounds. For a few years they played games in the tabernacle until the old gym was built about 1918.

In 1923 Deputy won the sectional. On Friday, March 6, Deputy defeated Saluda 55 to 8. Saturday, March 7, Deputy had to play three games to become the winner. On Saturday morning the team defeated Vevay 27 to 17. Saturday afternoon Madison was defeated 31 to 15. The final game was Saturday evening when the Deputy Panthers defeated Scottsburg 19 to 15. Deputy went to the regional and was defeated by Connersville 33 to 17. Members of the team were: Charles Henry, Roger Carlock, Virgil Kenworthy, LaMont Miller, Howard Nay, Roy Sparks, "Red" McNeely, and Russell Henry. The coach was Harley Clashman.

In 1950 Deputy won the Jefferson County Tourney. On Wednesday, January 18, Deputy defeated Saluda 38 to 32. On Thursday, January 19, the Panthers defeated North Madison 37 to 33. Members of the team were: Daryl Ellis, Donald Baxter, George Cochran, Owen Cole, Donald Howard, Tommy Royalty, Bill Bush, Bobby McCreery, Buddy Shelton, and Leroy Sipe. The coach was Raymond Barnes.

In 1954 the new high school was completed and the first graduating class was in 1955. From 1961 to 1966 the student body was increased when students from Paris Crossing transferred to Deputy. From 1912 to 1968, 786 have graduated from Deputy High School. 76 of these graduates have become teachers and 12 are in the process of becoming teachers.

The graduating class of 1968 will have an even sadder graduation as this will be the last class ever to graduate from Deputy, but they are proud to be the ones to complete their entire four years at THEIR Deputy High School.

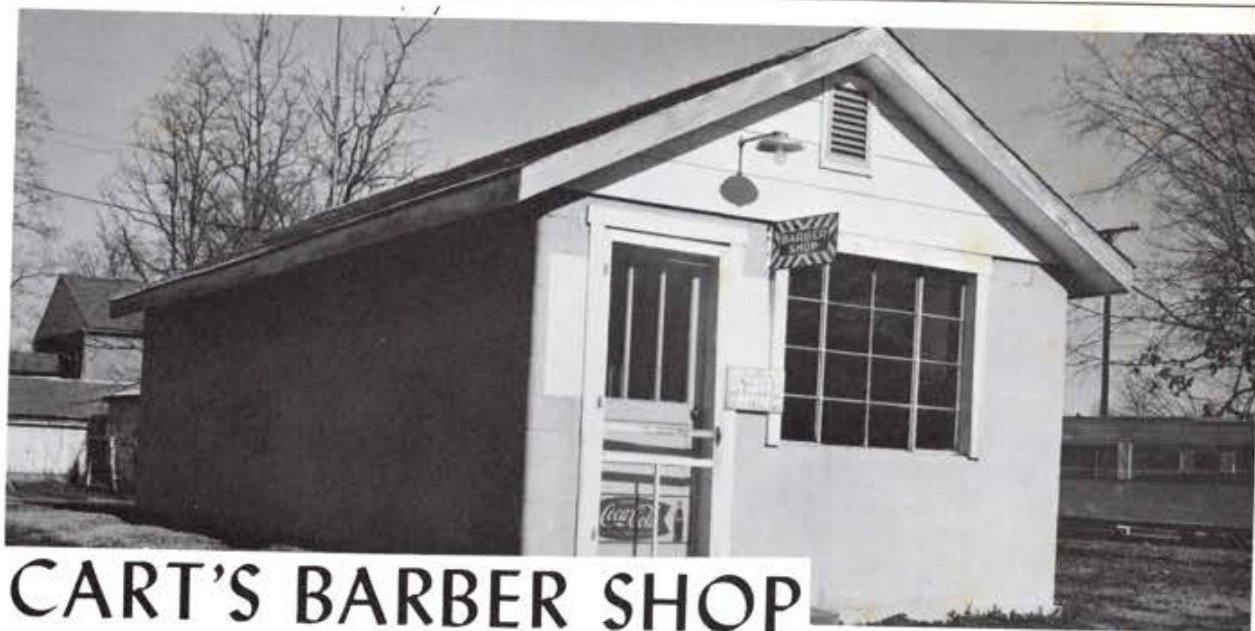
