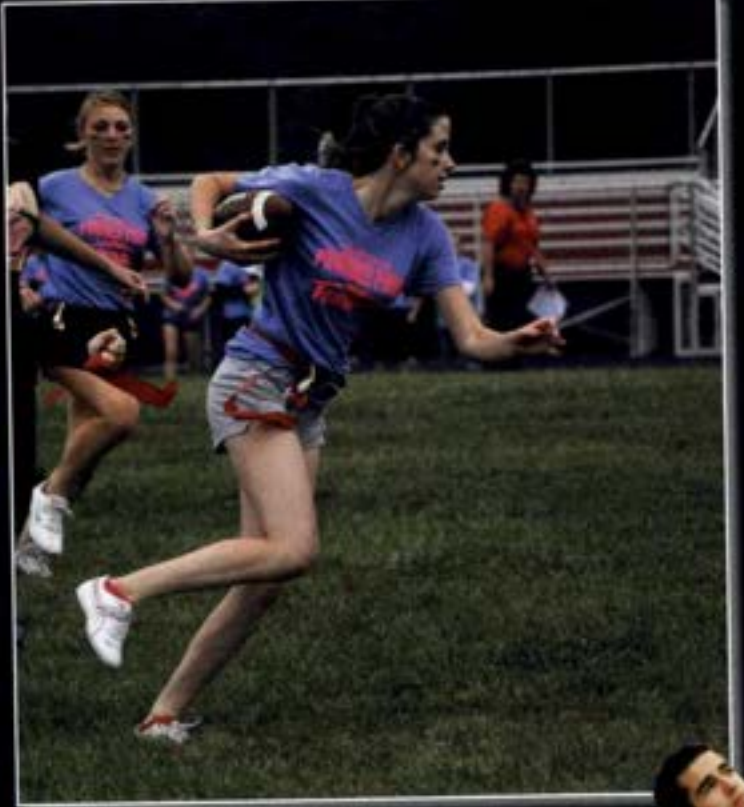

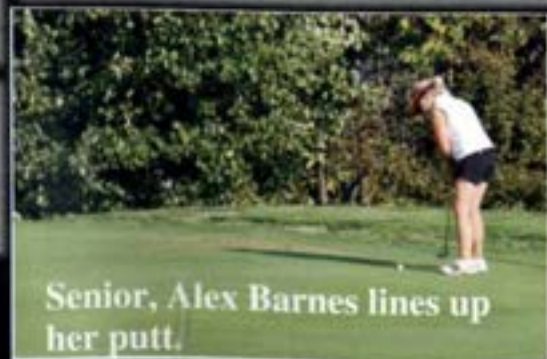

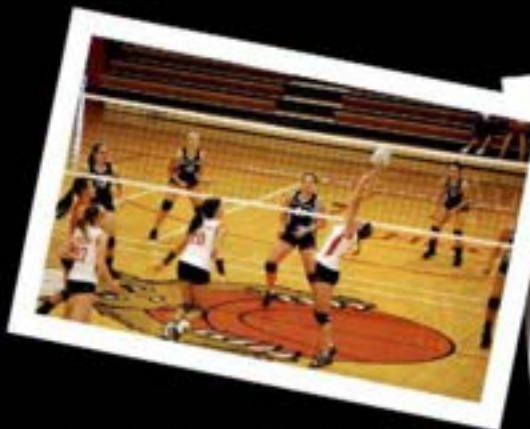

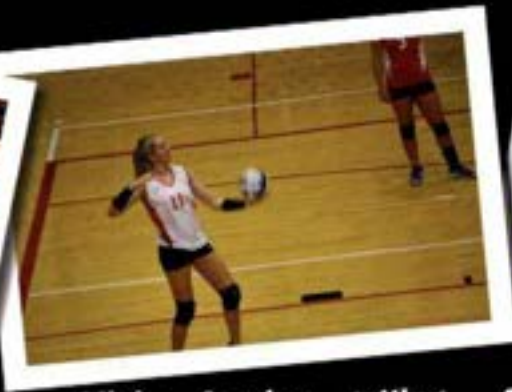

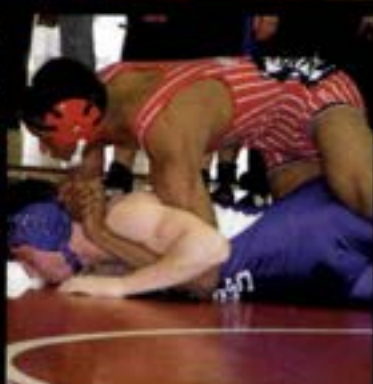
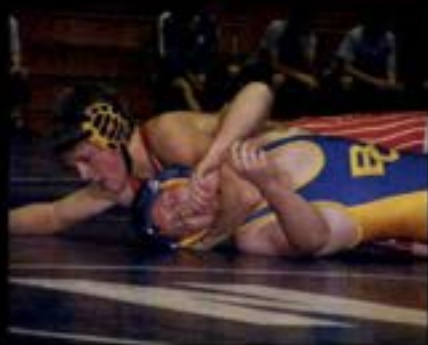
What is wrestling?

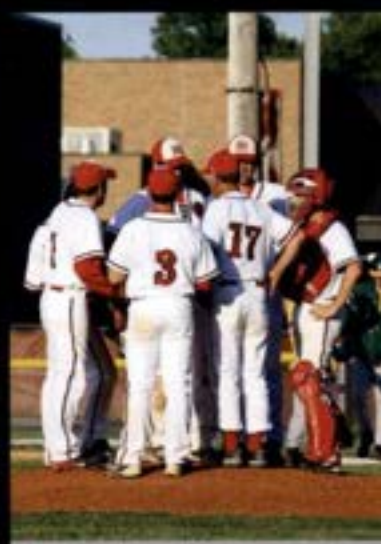
