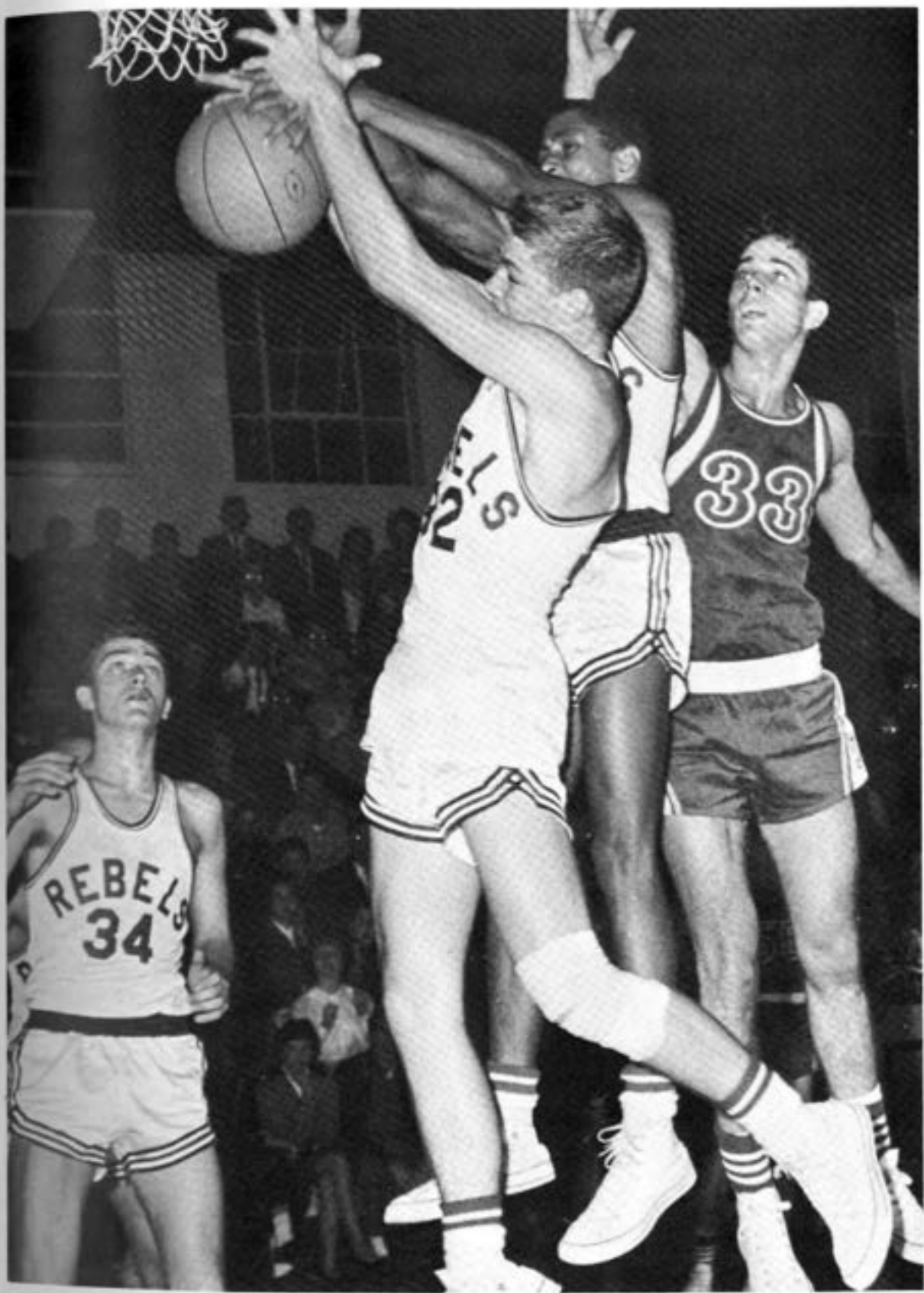
## Basketball
