After a record high less than a year ago, gasoline prices dropped, reaching a five-year low at one point. Despite falling prices, Americans continued to drive less.








Wind Storm

On the warm evening of May 20th the Madison Jefferson County Courthouse caught fire. The sad event caused a gathering that many compared to "a regatta crowd."


