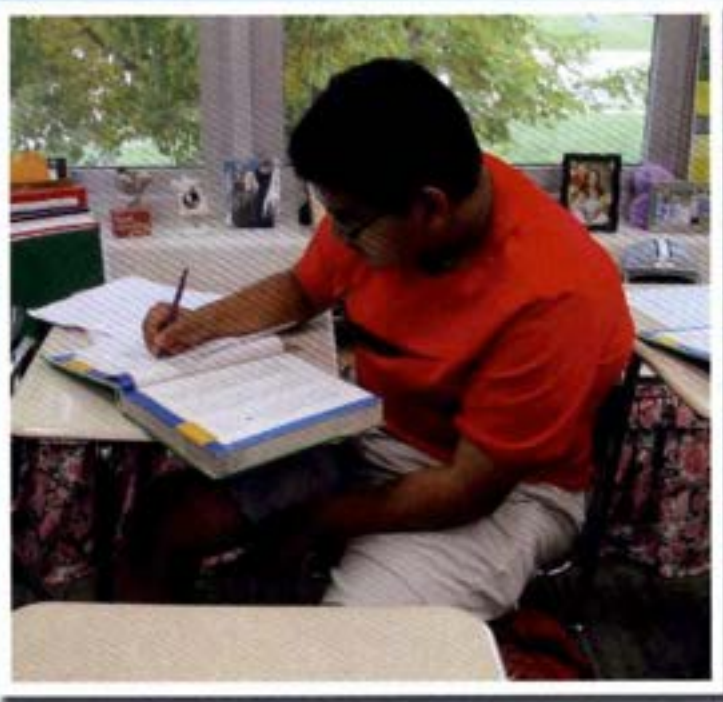


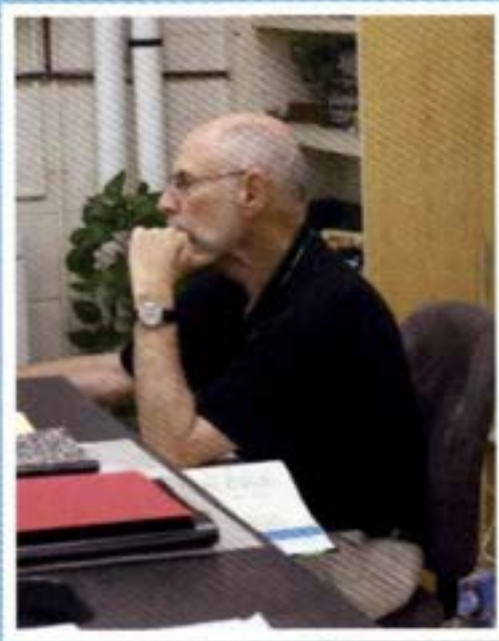




FOREIGN LANGUAGE

SCIENCE

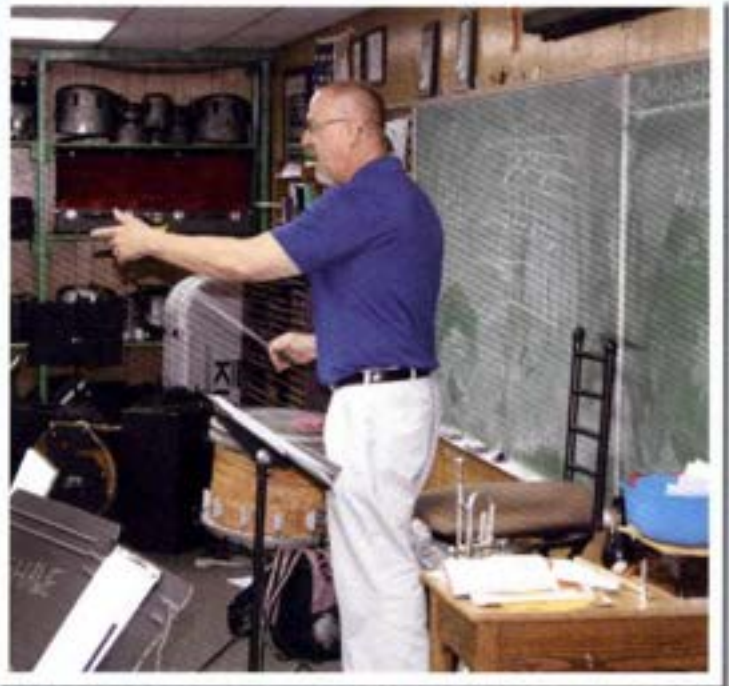

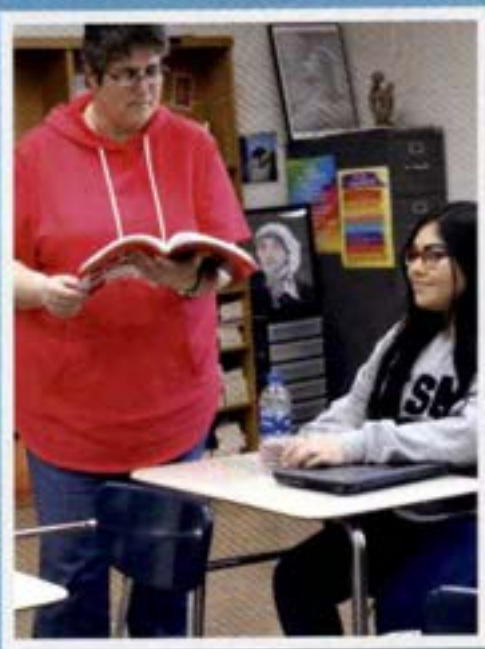




P.E. & HEALTH

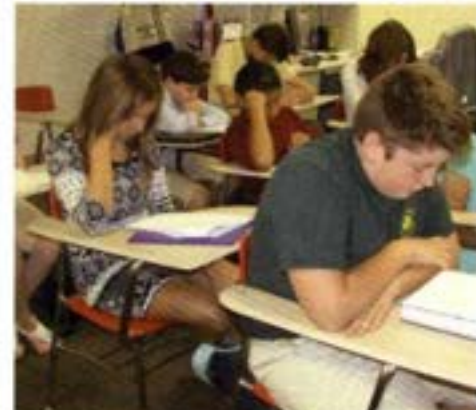




LANGUAGE

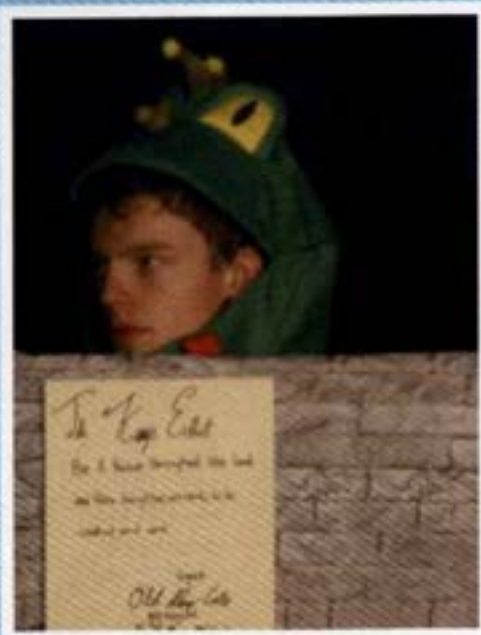




STUDENT PUBLICATIONS

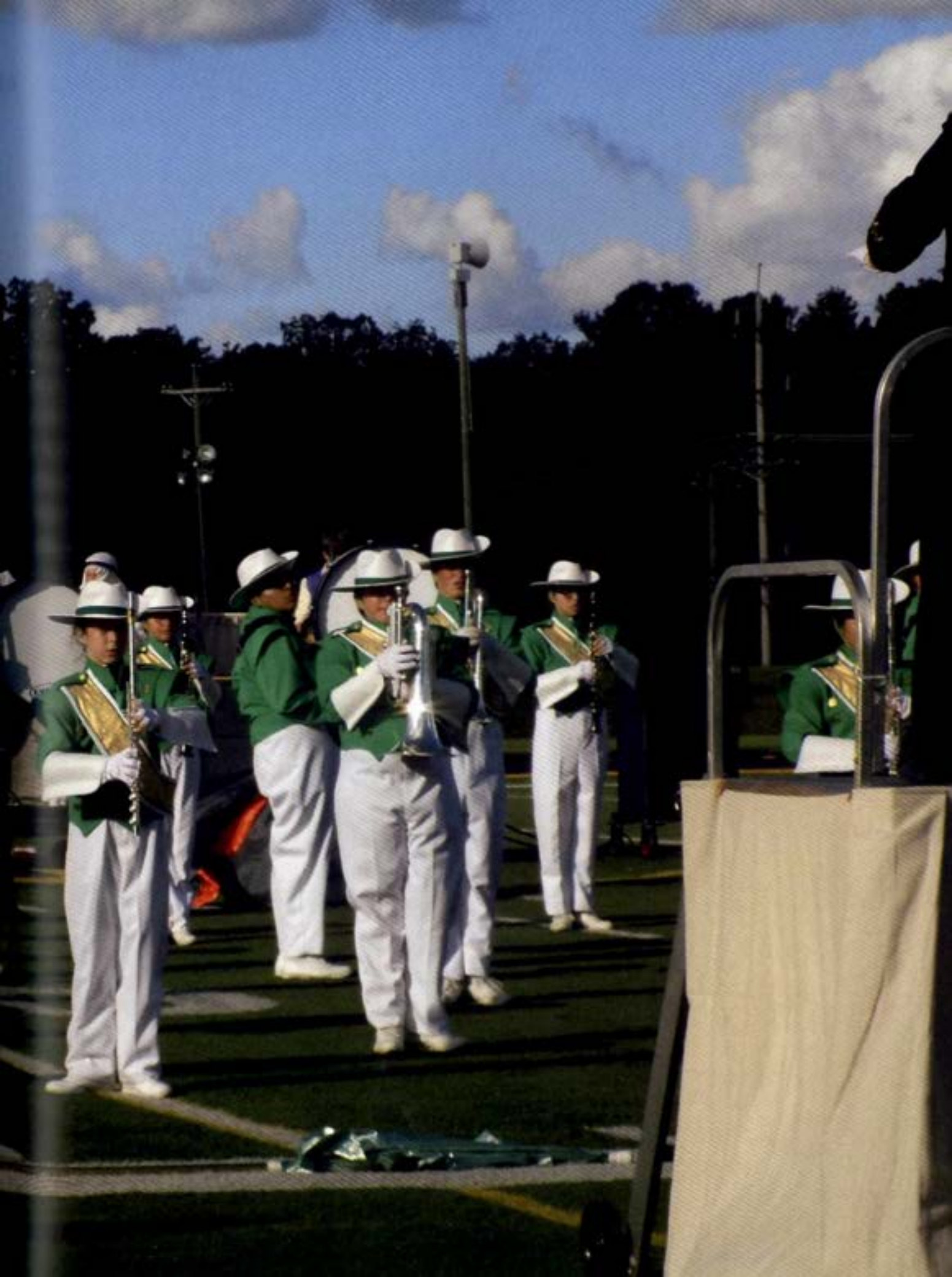
THEATRE
